TEAMUP CCPA TERMS

These Teamup CCPA Terms ("**CCPA Terms**") supplement the Teamup Terms of Service available at <u>https://www.teamup.com/terms-of-service/</u> or other agreement between you or the entity you represent and Teamup governing your use of the Service Offerings (the "**Agreement**") when the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 as amended, including as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act of 2020, together with any implementing regulations (collectively "**CCPA**") applies to your use of the Services to process personal information that is uploaded to the Services under your Teamup accounts ("**Personal Information**"). For purposes of these CCPA Terms, "commercial purpose," "personal information," "process," "sell," and "share" shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the CCPA. Unless otherwise defined in these CCPA Terms, all capitalized terms used in these CCPA Terms will have the meanings given to them in the Agreement.

Teamup agrees that it will:

- a. process Personal Information pursuant to the Agreement for the purposes specified in Section 5 of the <u>Data Processing Agreement</u>;
- b. not retain, use, or disclose Personal Information for any purpose, including any commercial purpose, except as permitted in the Agreement or under CCPA;
- c. not retain, use, or disclose Personal Information outside the direct business relationship between Teamup and Customer, including by not combining any Personal Information with other personal information collected or received from another source, except as permitted by CCPA; and
- d. not sell or share Personal Information.

Teamup will inform you if it determines that Teamup can no longer meet its obligations under CCPA. If Teamup is engaged in the unauthorized use of Personal Information, Customer may, upon reasonable notice to Teamup, take reasonable and appropriate steps to stop and remediate the unauthorized use of Personal Information. These CCPA Terms do not limit or reduce any other data privacy commitments Teamup makes to you in the Agreement.
